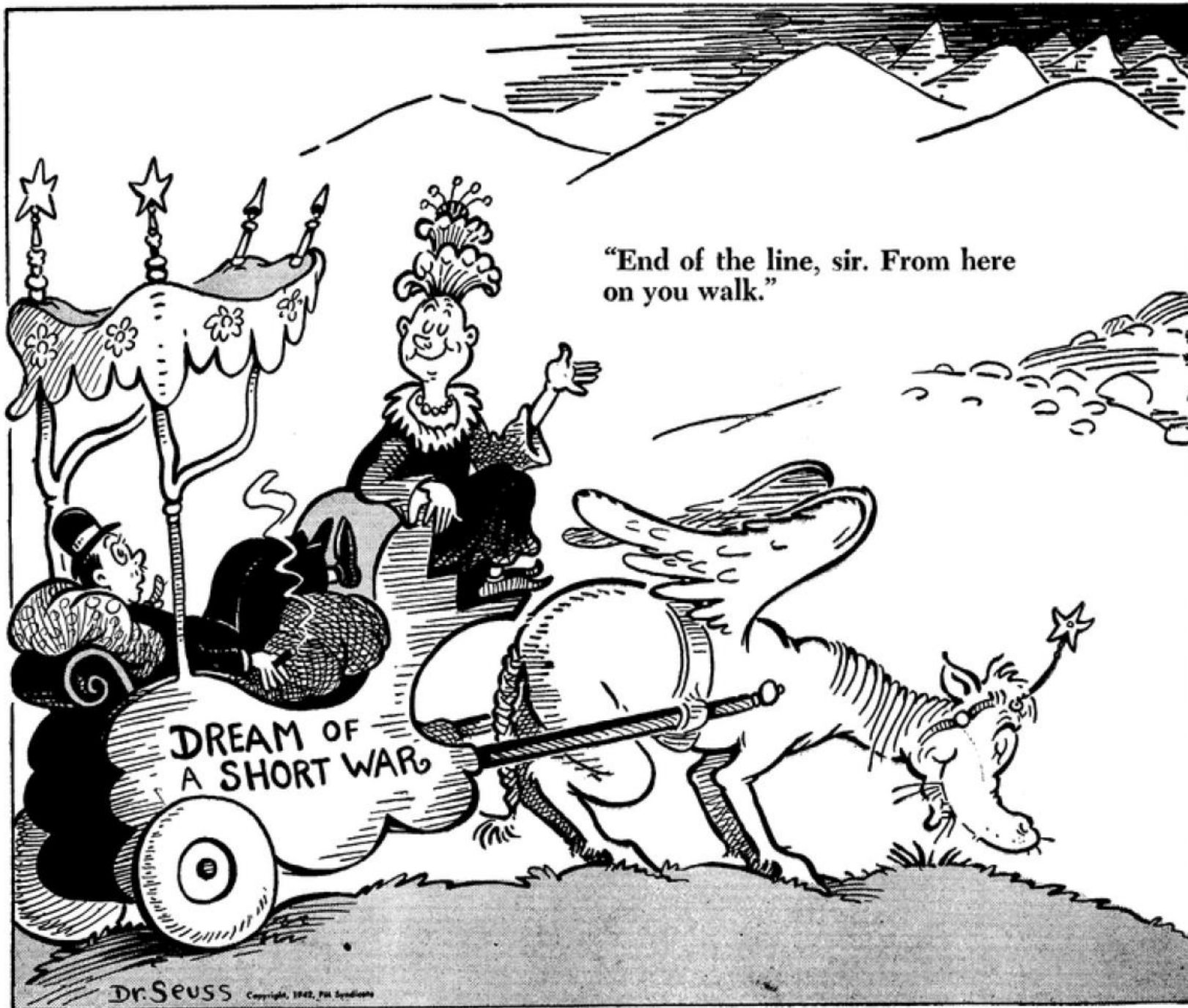


Dr. Seuss' History
